


Comprehensive 'Train the Trainer' programme on an innovative open source platform – ELGG

For delivering the 'Train the Trainer' programme for Vocational Education, Employability and Adult Education providers, on the effective use of Web 2.0 and social networking media for improving the employability of mature adult job seekers, the Web2jobs project consortium has chosen the ELGG platform.

The platform is based on ELGG engine including Web2.0 facilities and the capability to create a community of users that can interact between themselves (like on Facebook or LinkedIn).




The main parts of the platform are:

- The Login facility for Web2jobs users (Trainers, Trainer of Trainers, Trainees and technical administrators);
- The Modules for users accessing the training contents;
- The Members Zone that aims at presenting the members of the Web2jobs Community;
- The Web2jobs Header including shortcut menus for accessing the aforementioned facilities and the Search engine to browse within the platform.

The platform is being developed by the French partner - ORT France and all partners are contributing with contents for the learning modules.

Piloting of the Train the Trainer' programme

A first pilot will take part in all partner countries in the beginning of April 2015, while a second pilot is planned starting with June 2015.
