

## Web2jobs project – fourth transnational partnership meeting

The fourth transnational meeting of partners took place in Trabzon, Turkey during 12-14 May 2015 and was hosted by the Turkish partner, Karadeniz Technical University. The main aim of the meeting was to review the results of the first pilot of the ‘Train the Trainer’ programme and to work on improving the training materials and plan the details for the second pilot.

## First pilot of the Train the Trainer’ programme

During March-April 2015, a number of 61 trainers from all the 8 partner countries piloted the ‘Train the Trainer’ programme developed by the Web2jobs project on the effective use of Web 2.0 and social networking media for improving the employability of mature adult job seekers.

The pilot consisted of an explanation of the contents and structure of the entire training and a more in-depth experience of at least 3 modules by each trainer, out of the 10 developed modules.

The training was delivered as blended learning: face to face sessions and self-study on the ELGG platform of the project.

The suggestions for improvement made by the trainers in terms of content, pedagogy and learning environment are currently being used by partners for providing a second improved version of the ‘Train the Trainer’ programme.

## Fourth partners’ meeting, Trabzon, Turkey, 12-14 May 2015






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Partners agreed on a new common structure for the **Blended Learning Modules:**



It is envisaged that each module would involve approximately four learning hours (including introduction and self-assessment). The whole programme would be achievable within 40 guided learning hours. The modules will clearly identify the elements to be delivered ‘face-to-face’, as group work and as self-study. The final face-to-face session should include an assessment of learning against objectives and ‘Next Steps’ action planning.

**Second pilot of the training programme:**

In September 2015, the partners will organize a second pilot of the training programme with trainers working in vocational education, employability and adult education. After completing the training, the involved trainers will deliver the programme at their turn to end users – at least 6 adults over 45 from disadvantaged communities per trainer.
