

Fifth transnational partnership meeting of the Web2jobs project

The fifth transnational meeting of partners took place in Paris, France during 27th -29th October 2015 and was hosted by the French partner, ORT Innovation. The main aims of the meeting were to review the results of the second pilot of the 'Train the Trainer' programme, to plan the third pilot with end users and to discuss the final steps of the project, in view of preparing the final report.

Second pilot with training successfully completed

During September-October 2015, the 8 partner organisations have run the second pilot of the 'Train the Trainer' programme with employability trainers on the effective use of Web 2.0 and social networking media for improving the employability of mature adult job seekers.

The aim of pilot 2 was to assess the improved version of the training modules, based on the recommendations from pilot 1. Trainers were asked whether the revised training sufficiently addressed their needs and whether the ELGG e-platform was easy to use, for themselves and for end users.


Pilot 2 was organized also as a blended learning programme, consisting of face-to-face sessions and self-study on the ELGG platform of the project.

The overall evaluation shows that trainers have expressed their appreciation for the improved modules.

Several improvement recommendations were also made, in view of making the training more fit for purpose for pilot 3 that will be organised with end users in the next phase. Although the training situation is very diverse for the different partners involved, the training contains enough interesting subjects for training in all the countries.

What is next?

Third pilot with end users

After refining the modules based on the feedback from pilot 2, a third pilot will be organised during November-December 2015 with end users - 45+ jobseekers. The trainers involved in pilot 2 will deliver, at their turn, the training programme to groups of 6-8 end users, based on their needs.

The impact and results of pilot 3 will be used for producing the final version of the training programme.

As well, partners will develop a trainer guide for the entire training programme, which is considered to be a useful addition to the product in order to enhance and broaden its usefulness.

Further exploitation of the results

During the remaining period of the project, partners will focus also on planning and carrying out activities for ensuring the further use and exploitation of the main results, including submitting the training programme for accreditation, where the national context allows it.
